**Eligible Students:** full-time students studying NQ Higher Pathway to Science (with Chemistry), HNC Applied Science Level 7 (on Chemistry route) and HND Applied Science Level 8 (on Chemistry route).

- Able to clearly demonstrate this commitment both on your application form and during an interview
- Proven high levels of attendance

## 2. Application Procedure

Application forms are available on our website. It is important that applicants complete the form fully and explain clearly why they should be considered for an Angela Stewart Grant Scholarship. Shortlisted students will be invited to an informal interview. Successful applicants will be required to be photographed at the presentation of their award for publicity purposes. References from a relevant Curriculum Manager will be requested.
