Who Can Apply for the Scholarship?

Full-time students, preferably those who are looking to articulate on to university after their college course. Students should be enrolled at Fife College studying from August 2021 in the following subjects:

- HNC or HND Electrical Engineering
- HNC or HND Mechanical Engineering
- HNC/D Computing: Software Development
- HNC Manufacturing Engineering
- HNC Computer Aided Draughting and Design
- HNC Fabrication, Welding and Inspection

Modern Apprenticeship students studying SVQ Level 2, NC or HNC day release courses in engineering related subjects are also eligible to apply.

Students should be committed to their studies and ideally to articulating on to degree level study at any university after their college course.

What will you be awarded?

A maximum £500 is available per student.

What can you spend the scholarship on?

The scholarship should be used for resources or materials that will help you with your studies, such as a laptop, software, tools equipment or expenses such as travel. It is also a reward for the work and time committed by you on your chosen project.

How to apply?

Decide which project you wish to join and contact the project.

Once accepted on to one of the projects, you can apply for the scholarship via [the scholarship page](#) on the Fife College website. Please complete the online application form and personal statement.

What happens next?

We will read your application and you may be asked to attend an interview. Your lecturer will be asked for references to support applications.

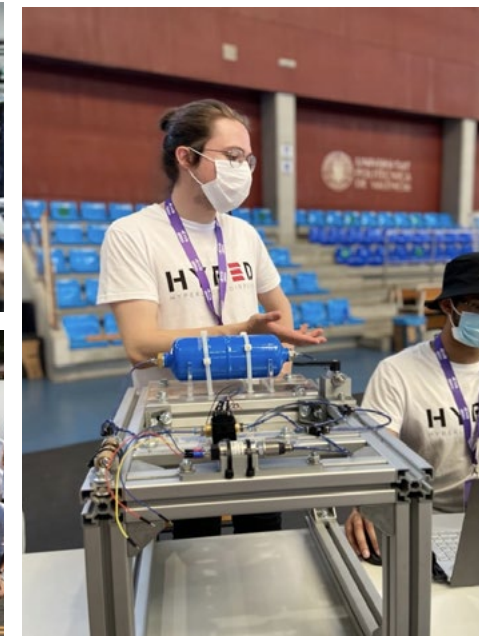
