Helen Moyes Scholarship Guidelines

What is the Helen Moyes Scholarship?

This scholarship was set up in memory of Helen Moyes (1904 to 1981), to support Fife College students and give them a helping hand to progress their studies or find employment.

Helen was born in Kirkcaldy in to a different world with few opportunities available to her. She left school at 14 and was a working mum for most of her married life. Helen was a great advocate of self-improvement through education and encouraged all her family into further education to help them follow their dreams and aspirations.

Helen would consider herself a very ordinary person - her family know she was extremely special and have therefore set up this scholarship in memory of her so her encouragement and belief in the power of education can help others to transform their lives.

Those students studying the following courses at the Dunfermline and Rosyth Campuses:

- **HNC Social Services** – **Dunfermline Campus**
- **ICDL SCQF Levels 4 and 5** – **Dunfermline Campus**
- **HNC Mechanical Engineering (part-time only)** – **Rosyth Campus**

What Do You Receive?

There are financial awards available up to £500 per HNC scholarship, 2x£250 for the ICDL scholarship. Award amounts may change at the discretion of the panel.
