

Bursary 25 & Over

If you have a partner/spouse, your award will be assessed on their Gross Income earned in the previous tax year 2021-2022.

Any award is based on your personal circumstances including any children dependent on you and any unearned income you receive.

The maximum you will be awarded is:

Basic Evidence Required

25+ Bursary
ID – Birth Certificate, Passport, Driving Licence, MyFife Card, NHS Medical Card
Proof of your address – official letter addressed to student (cannot be from Fife College)
Tax Credit Award – For year 2021/2022 (please make sure to send all pages)
P60 Covering April 2021 – March 2022 for partner
Council Tax Notification 2022 - if single person
Benefit Letter/screen shot of at least 6 Months Universal Credit Award showing name, address and all elements awarded (this includes deductions)
ID of Dependent Children – Birth Certificates, Passport, Driving Licence, NHS Medical Card or MyFife Card

We may ask for additional evidence depending on your circumstances.

Travel Expenses

Travel award is subject to an assessment of household income. You need to live more than two miles away as the crow flies from the college campus, and not be in receipt of DLA/PIP or Adult/Child disability payment mobility element.

The travelling expenses are calculated on the cheapest form of public transport available. Travel is only paid for the time that you are travelling to college.
