Climate Change Scholarship Guidelines

What is the Climate Change Scholarship?

Egypt will host the 27th **UN Climate Change Conference of the Parties (COP27)** in Sharm El Sheikh on 6 – 18 November 2022. To mark the occasion, raise awareness of the event and the issues around climate change, we are launching our Climate Change Scholarship, sponsored by the Earlseat Wind Farm Covid Relief Fund.

What Do You Receive if Successful?

First prize – new laptop and £250

Runner up prize – £250

Who Can Apply?

This exciting scholarship is open to **ALL** Fife College students who have an interest in climate change, have good levels of attendance and are keen to use their qualifications to enhance their career prospects.

How to Apply

To enter please submit your thoughts on the theme '**What climate change means to me**' – your application can be:

- an essay (up to 1,500 words)
- a piece of art: sculpture, painting, drawing, photograph etc.
- a short video
- a presentation (such as PowerPoint)

Please choose one of the above or another medium.

If you are submitting an essay please use the space provided on the application form. If your entry is a piece of art please forward a photo of it to scholarships@fife.ac.uk and put a description on the application as to what it means to you and relates to climate change. Presentations, videos and other formats should be emailed to scholarships@fife.ac.uk

The panel will be looking for original and thoughtful contributions, highlighting any measures you personally take to combat climate change or raise awareness in your day to day life.

Your essay, description or presentation may include thoughts on the impacts of climate change, how to tackle it, what it means to you personally, or how your course is focusing on climate change.

What Can You Spend the Scholarship Money On?

The scholarship should be used for resources or materials that would help you with your studies.
