### Scholarship Guidelines

#### What is the Arnold Clark Scholarship?

This scholarship supports and recognises students' commitment to progressing their career especially within the areas of business, engineering and automotive skills. In the past this scholarship has benefitted students to support them while they study and has also resulted in some students gaining employment with Arnold Clark, Europe's largest privately-owned car retailer.



#### Who Can Apply?

**Engineering skills;** For full-time engineering students who are able to demonstrate a keen interest in automotive technology, currently studying any of the following;

- Introduction to Engineering and Technology (including Automotive Skills) Level 4
- Gateway to Engineering (Including Automotive) Certificate Level 4
- Gateway to Engineering (Including Electrical) Certificate Level 4
- IMI Award Transport Maintenance IMI Level 1
- IMI Award Transport Maintenance IMI Level 2
- IMI Award Transport Maintenance IMI Level 3
- NC Engineering Practice Level 5
- NC Electrical Engineering Level 5
- NC Fabrication & Welding Level 5

**Business skills:** For full-time business students who are able to demonstrate a keen interest in automotive business administration and management, and are currently studying any of the following:

- Advanced Certificate: Accounting.
- Advanced Certificate: Business, Administration Incorporating AI.
- Intermediate Certificate: Business Administration and Accounting with Law.

#### What Do You Receive?

There are two **£1,000 awards** which may be split amongst other students at the discretion of the interview panel.

#### What Can You Spend the Scholarship On?

The scholarship should be used for resources or materials that would help you with your studies such as tools, travel, a laptop, software, books, or home study space. It can also help support you as you take that next step in to future studies or employment.

#### How to Apply

**References** We may ask a staff member who knows you for a reference.
